

COLOR OUR “LUNG MASCOT”

Drawing Contest organized for children aged 4 to 12 by the Belgian Lung Foundation in collaboration with the Train World museum.

1 - ORGANIZER

This drawing contest is organized by the Belgian Lung Foundation, located at Researchdreef 10, 1070 Anderlecht, Belgium.

2 - CONTEST THEME

The theme of the contest is: «Protect Your Lungs!» Participants are invited to color our «lung mascot» and use their creativity by adding their own elements or details to the original drawing, such as:

- a beautiful background
- trees or flowers as a symbol of clean air
- characters doing sports or physical activity
- a blue sky or clouds
- and other elements that evoke breathing and lung health

They can also make the mascot “speak” by adding a text balloon.

3 - CONTEST DURATION

The contest starts on 19 November 2025 and ends on 1 March 2026 at midnight.

4 - PARTICIPATION CONDITIONS

- The contest is open to all children aged 4 to 12.
- Participation is free.
- Each child may submit only one drawing.
- Drawings must be made by hand (pencils).
- Works must be personal and original.

5 - SUBMISSION

Drawings can be submitted at the Train World Museum shop or sent by post to: BeLF – Researchdreef 10 – 1070 Anderlecht, Belgium by 1 March 2026 at midnight (postmark will be proof). Each drawing must include:

- the child’s first name, last name, and age
- the name and phone number of a parent or legal guardian

6 - SELECTION AND JURY

Drawings will be evaluated by a jury composed of Belgian Lung Foundation staff. The jury will select a maximum of 10 drawings. Jury decisions are final.

The jury will evaluate the works based on:

- adherence to the theme
- originality
- creativity of the artist.

7 - PRIZES AND AWARDS

The ten winners will receive craft supplies (for participants aged 4 to 6) or books (for participants aged 6 to 12). Winners (or their legal representatives) will be personally contacted on Monday, 16 March 2026. The winning works will also be displayed on our website from that date:

By participating in the contest, children (and their legal representatives) grant the Belgian Lung Foundation permission to publish the drawings as part of the contest, non-commercially, with the child’s first name and age mentioned.

10 - ACCEPTANCE OF THE RULES

Participation in the contest implies full acceptance of these rules.
